





# Our environment

Teachers and families: the early childhood and primary school curricula focus on helping children take care of the environment.

You can encourage young children to care for our environment while playing, or while watching educational shows like *Sesame Street* together.



## Watch together

While you're watching Sesame Street or other educational content together, build on what children are noticing.

#### Food and our environment

While watching *Cookie Monster Foodie Truck*, talk together about how foods grow and what foods need in order to grow.

- ☐ Children can think about what might happen to these foods if we didn't care for our environment and how they can help.
- ☐ Talk about ways you can prevent food waste, such as by eating leftovers and sharing extra food with others.

#### **Grow foods and compost**

- ☐ All children can help you to grow simple foods, plants or herbs inside or outside.
- ☐ Compost together by putting uncooked fruit and vegetable scraps, newspaper and leaves in a bin or hole in your garden. Then, cover it so it can rot without pests.



### Play and learn together

#### Reduce and recycle

- ☐ Set an example for all children by modelling how to do simple things like throwing garbage in the bin and sorting bottles for recycling and reuse.
- ☐ Even infants and toddlers can have fun throwing bottles in the recycling box.

#### Appreciate the environment

☐ Take walks and play outside with infants and toddlers and name all of the wonderful things nature has to offer.

#### **Make posters**

- Children can create posters for their home and school to remind others of what they can do to help their environment.
- ☐ Pre-schoolers can draw, scribble or try to write words while primary school children can draw and write words or sentences.
- ☐ You can use pictures of children doing the different actions to encourage them to be proud to help the environment.



While you're playing and talking together, ask questions like:

- ☐ What do you notice about our environment?
- ☐ Why do you think it's important to \_\_\_?
- ☐ How can we help to take care of \_\_\_?
- ☐ What do you like about our environment? What can we do to help it?
