Theme: Jamaica Land We Love

Sub Theme: Our Visitors

Concept / Content

We can make our visitors feel welcome by being kind and friendly to them; when we make them feel welcome, they will want to return to our country.

Objective(s): after watching YouTube video, children should be able to:

- > Name at Least 5 Places Tourist Can Visit in Jamaica
- > Tell who is a tour guide
- Share different expressions tourists would show when visiting various Jamaican attractions.
- > Dramatize welcoming tourist coming to Jamaica.

Resources: YouTube video, pictures of Jamaican attraction, word card, clothing items, hats, shoes, eyeglasses, facial chart.

Activities: What children will be encouraged to: to watch YouTube video

Preparation:

Allow child /children to watch a video of entitled JAMAICA
ATTRACTIONS (4K)

- * Identify the different tourist attractions seen in the video.
- Talk about the facial expressions seen on the tourist faces, and their body language
- * Identify the facial expressions on the facial chart
- Talk freely about who is a tour guide (A tour guide or a tourist guide is a person who provides assistance, information on cultural, historical and contemporary heritage to people on organized tours and individual clients at educational establishments, religious and historical sites, museums, and at venues of other significant interest, attractions sites.)

Assessment:

 Allow child/children to dress up and role play being a tourist or a tour guide.

Activities: Parents will encourage and monitor activity:

- * Assist child/children designing a welcome to Jamaica poster
- * Recite the following poem about Jamaica


